Laredo Theater Guild International 2019 Class on Stage Student Poster Art Contest

Rules & Guidelines

Theme: William Shakespeare's Hamlet

The winning artist will receive \$250 and will have his/her artwork featured on the poster and other advertising for Hamlet, LTGI's Class on Stage Series production to be held Fall, 2019 at TAMIU.

Specifically, judges will consider the following:

- Does the artwork relate to the contest's theme? Does the artist convey the theme clearly?
- Is the theme presented in a unique way? Is it original?
- Does the artwork provide evidence of creativity and individuality? Is the result distinctive? Does it leave an impression?
- Did the artist effectively compose and organize the elements and principles of art? Is the artwork aesthetically pleasing?
- Does the artwork show evidence of a mastery of the tools and techniques utilized? Are the use of tools and techniques well executed?

Entry Guidelines

- Contest is open to middle school, high school and college students whose school lies within a 75-mile radius of downtown Laredo.
- Artwork must be 2D and may be created in any medium.
- Artwork must be submitted by July 15, 2019.
- Artwork can be of any shape or size but must fit within a 20" x 20" square and cannot exceed 1" in thickness. (Artwork may be smaller than 20" x 20".)
- Artwork must be completely dry/cured. Chalk and pastel submissions must be sprayed with fixative.
- Artwork must be unsigned.
- Artists may only submit one entry. Group art projects and collective efforts are not eligible.
- There is NO requirement to include any text on the artwork. However IF the artist chooses to include text, the only text allowed is "William Shakespeare's Hamlet" or "Hamlet by William Shakespeare"

Non-winning artwork may be exhibited during the run of the show. Artwork may be picked up after October 15, 2019 (Monday-Friday, 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM) at Blue Top Digital Reprographics.

LTGI reserves the right not to award the prize.
